Pool

The LaSolana pool remains open for your daily use. Max of 10 people in the pool itself and an additional 14 utilizing the chairs surrounding the pool area. Chairs must remain at their current locations and everyone must follow social distance guidelines. No guests are permitted unless they are actually staying at your unit. Please be courteous of others.

Clubhouse

The Clubhouse is closed for the time being. One exception is on Tuesdays and Fridays from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm, library and computer room will be open. Limited to 1 person at a time in the library to obtain books and/or puzzles to take home and in the computer room. Maximum time of 30 minutes per person in the computer lab as computers will need to be sanitized after each use. Contact the office to reserve a time in the computer lab. A committee has been formed to develop guidelines to safely open the Clubhouse in the future.

Social Activities

Unfortunately, Social activities which are normally scheduled have been canceled until the first of the year. At that time, social activities will be reconsidered depending on the COVID-19 situation. LaSolana has so many inviting grassy areas to use for your social time with friends while still maintaining social distancing. It's easy, bring your chair, your beverage of choice and enjoy conversations with friends and other residents. Remember to wear your mask and sanitize as necessary.

Security

The Security at the LaSolana community is extremely important to all of us here.
