

Did You Know that there is broken curbing around the trail at the end of building 4 and 5? Carescape will be soon removing all the broken curbing and installing approximately 128 feet of new curbing.

Did You Know that only 14 Pine Trees remain? 7 of the Pine Trees will be removed this year and the remaining 7 in 2026. Unfortunately, when these trees were planted to entice buyers they were planted over water lines causing many problems. The ruptured water lines have been quite costly over the past years. In addition to water line damages, they leave pinecones and tree debris making the grounds not so becoming.

Did You Know that more turf reduction will soon begin? The Board made this decision to first and foremost to save on water, second, to refrain from watering areas were grass won't grow, third, to save money on costs of reseeding, weeding, and mowing, and fourth, to plant more color in areas where grass won't grow. It's time to look at low water usage plants and find shurbs/plants which will add more color to the grounds.

Did You Know that there are 2 new Board Members? Please give a warm La Solana welcome to Norbert Herrera, Member at Large and Claudia Jurowski, Secretary. Board positions are difficult to fill, and we appreciate them for volunteering to take on their new roles on the Board.

Did You Know that the Flag at the Main Entrance has been temporarily taken down? The current flood light wasn't providing adequate lighting for the Flag. Due to that the decision was made until proper lighting can be installed the Flag will remain down at this time. We appreciate all the Veterans and owners for bringing this to our attention.
